## OVERVIEW

Starting from the Ruthin quarry car park, you will walk through the abandoned architecture of the old quarry, including wireway pylons formerly used for transporting the stone and various stone processing buildings. This gives way to magnificent views over the rolling countryside. You will then ascend to the Trig Point and lone wind turbine before descending and making your way back to the start, taking in the old school building near the walk end.

**Distance / terrain:** 5 miles. roads, footpaths, fields one steep climb
