Some lovely views over Cardiff from St Augustine's Church and a good view along the coast from Penarth Head Park where we will stop for a coffee break (weather permitting). The walk includes the middle class Villadom and the working class Daggertown, and I am sure that walkers will find the life of our hero interesting - his gravestone reads

“Who lived and died the happiest man on earth, who was always busy doing good and trying to do good advising and helping those in trouble”.
