Nic will give a description of the 1919 race riots on Barry's streets and what happened on the 11th, 12th, 13th of June 1919. What it was like in Barry in 1919 in the aftermath of the Race Riots?

Merthyr Dyfan Cemetery stands at just over 55 acres in size and provides a valuable green sanctuary for the town. Note this is a stop and talk walk.
